WEATHER CONDITIONS

The 2023 vintage reflects the trend of global warming, with an early vine growth cycle followed by a spring frost that affected our Merlot vines. The summer season was far from straightforward. It was marked by a series of stormy spells that encouraged the development of downy mildew. However, our effective pest management and the dedication of our teams ensured the quality of the harvest was preserved. A heatwave then set in during August, resulting in a significant loss of berry weight on the gravelly-sandy soils, but it also encouraged the grapes to ripen beautifully.

THE HARVEST

An early harvest began on 13 September at Château Beaumont. The warm weather enabled us to spread the harvest over 2 weeks so that we could pick our three grape varieties in the best possible conditions. The berries harvested are concentrated.
